The difference between grooming and hospice care is to keep your pet as comfortable as possible while not causing any further stress. Focus is on comfort not beauty or perfection. I aim to groom in the way that is most tolerated.

Grooming is stressful to many pets and so there is a chance that the ailing pet may pass during their groom. I do everything I possibly can to lower the stress level for your pet, I give frequent breaks, control the noise level and alter the way I trim and style them.

Why groom at all? As your pet ages, many times they develop illnesses that make it difficult to keep them clean and safe, and so in an effort to keep them clean and safe they are isolated in a room where it is easier to control their movement. This separates the pet from the family unit and is very hard for both you and your pet. I believe every living creature deserves to live out their life clean, comfortable, and surrounded by their loved ones.
